CAMP INFORMATION

Registration Fee: A \$35.00 family registration fee is collected at time of registration for camp administrative costs and camp transportation fuel surcharge fee.

Field Trip and Special Activity Fees: During the course of camp, field trips and special activities may be offered. The fee for the field trip or special activity will be due two days prior to the date of the event. Advance notice will be given regarding event and cost.

Open Swim: Open swim time is available various days of the week to those students who can swim. Children are transported to Lockhart State Park by Lockhart ISD school buses and supervised by camp staff. Lifeguards are on duty during open swim time.

Swim Lessons: American Red Cross swim lessons are offered at Lockhart State Park during camp time. Children are transported by Lockhart ISD school buses to Lockhart State Park where they receive instruction by certified American Red Cross Water Safety Instructors. A lifeguard is on duty during class times. Classes are held Monday – Friday. Limited availability. Payment is due at time of registration.

Camp Staff: All camp staff are employees of Lockhart ISD with criminal history background checks and fingerprinting completed before hiring. Staff are required to follow policies and procedures outlined in the camp employee handbook as well as the district employee handbook. All staff are trained in CPR/First Aid as well as techniques to effectively engage campers. Staff will provide a safe, respectful, and nurturing environment for all campers.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch are provided free of charge for **ALL** campers each day. Meals are provided through the Lockhart ISD Summer Food Service Program.
