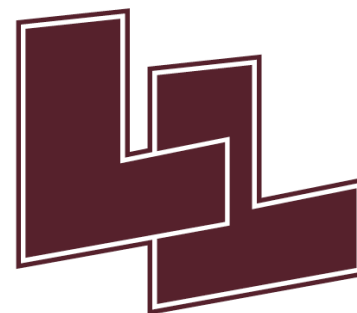

## Colvin named finalist for Texas Computer Education Association Library Media Specialist of the Year

Lockhart Junior High School Librarian Annie Colvin was honored Tuesday evening as a finalist for Texas Computer Education Association (TCEA) Library Specialist of the Year.

Each year, TCEA recognizes exemplary educators in Texas who have shown excellence in implementing technology in their classrooms, libraries, schools, and districts. Colvin's use of technology in the LJHS library made her a statewide standout, earning her this year's honor.
