Julie Hart opened the meeting at 5:30 pm. Introductions were made and the Council welcomed a new member, Debbie Sanders.

Randy Frye discussed the blog he set up last year. He explained possible reasons why people were having problems accessing the blog. The blog will be renamed and he will invite members to join again. The purpose of the blog is to distribute any information that may be of interest to the Council. Randy then answered questions including how to put information onto the blog.

Correction the January's Minutes: LISD received four new AEDs, not five as reported in last month's minutes. The goal is to purchase 5 more AEDs. This will provide coverage on every campus and major office.

Julie met with Phil McBride to discuss incorporation of wellness goals into district goals. Phil explained that for that to happen the wellness goals would need to be included in the campus templates that are compiled in the fall. Diabetes and CPR training should be included in these templates enumerating the current number of staff trained. The goal should be to increase these numbers. Julie explained the duties of the diabetic unlicensed assistants and how they are trained in steps to take when a diabetic emergency occurs. The training includes all other aspects of the disease including hands on training for giving injections and operation of glucose monitors.

Phil suggested that someone from this group should be present when the template for District goals is formed. Julie will attend the district meeting. This council will attempt to set up a mechanism to assure that wellness goals are incorporated into campus goals for next year.

Warren Lay from Lockhart Fire and Rescue will be having a conference with the National Weather Service people and would like to start scheduling storm preparation classes in March or April. He continues to work on brochures and welcomes suggestions.

Last week Julie emailed the new Federal Pre-pandemic Guidelines for Communities issued by the Center for Disease Control. This document is 108 pages long and contains valuable information regarding what the public needs to be prepared for and actions to take in the event that a pandemic does occur. Each member was given a handout of the Executive Summary. Julie explained that on page 11 scales could be found with actions to be taken for each level of a pandemic.

The last item up for discussion was the Diabetes Walk for Schools. Katie spoke with Ms. Hellurud, the HOSA sponsor who was enthused and interested in sponsoring a Diabetes walk for next year. The club will start to get the “ball rolling” for next year. Bluebonnet Elementary will sponsor a walk on March 9, 2007. Candi explained the process.

Since there was no new business to discuss the meeting adjourned at 6:20 pm. The next is set for March 5, 2007.
