<p>Description of Program: Lockhart ISD Community Education began providing programming during the Summer of 1975. In 1997 a full-day, nine-week summer camp was implemented with headquarters at Community Education. The program continues with an eight-week, full-day Sunsational Discovery Camp. Camp participants have the opportunity to take part in many summer camp classic activities as well as offered a variety of activities in active, creative, discovery and cooperative play. Theme-based programming and centers guarantee that campers are afforded new and exciting opportunities weekly. During the Summer of 2004, camp themes/classes were science, life skills, self-expression, creative communication, sports, and service. Staff developed and implemented daily lesson plans. Campers brought their lunch and snacks were provided by the life skills classes. The culmination of the week was on Fun Fridays! Fun Fridays were theme-based as well. Campers enjoyed “special activities” such as pampering day, face painting, hair clubs, hot wheel races, pep rallies, parades, staff/camper games, movies, water games and swimming.</p>
