What is Beanstack?

Beanstack is an online software that patrons can utilize to register for the 2021 Summer Reading Challenge for the Dr. Eugene Clark summer reading program. Sign up takes only a couple of minutes and is quick and easy! Here patrons can track books, minutes, log activities, and write books reviews.

How do patrons enroll in a program using Beanstack?

Patrons may access Beanstack through our library's webpage or using the URL lockharttx.beanstack.org

If you have already signed up for Beanstack in the past, via another library or school reading program, there is no need to re-register. Simply sign in and enroll for the Dr. Eugene Clark Library reading challenge. It is best to use the URL provided above to go straight to our library's content.

Once an **adult** signs up, they will see the available library programs <u>for their age</u> <u>group</u>. If an adult signs a child up, or a teen signs themselves up, they will see the programs available for their particular age group.

Reading Challenge Programs

Summer Reading Challenge (Books)	Ages 0-4 (babies/toddlers)
Summer Reading Challenge (Minutes)	Ages 5-10 (elementary children)
Summer Reading Challenge (Minutes)	Ages 11-17 (preteens/teens)
Adult Summer Reading Challenge (Minutes)	Ages 18+ (adults & seniors)

Preregistration opens on May 24th. *The 2021 challenge will not be visible before this date!*

How to Register for Beanstack

If you already have a Beanstack account, just sign in and register for our 2021 library's summer reading challenge *TAILS AND TALES*.

New Patrons:

- 1. Use the URL lockharttx.beanstack.org to access our Beanstack site.
- 2. Scroll all the way down and click Register an Individual or Family
- 3. Answer the question 'Have you used Beanstack?' Yes or No?
- 4. Click I am registering myself (the main account creator will be creating a username and password to log child's/children's reading).

***Please enter First/Last name, username, <u>phone number</u> (important for raffle drawing), password, and age.

- 5. Answer if this is your first time to complete a summer reading program.
- 6. Be sure to click Pre-Register (if registering before June 7th) and enter your gender and our library branch and click Register for this Challenge
- 7. Here you can register another adult or select 'NO' and enter your child's information. *Be sure to register ONE child at a time*.
- 8. Enter your child's First and Last name and their age.
- 9. On the next screen be sure to click Pre-Register enter your child's information and click Register for this Challenge

**If you are done entering all the children for your account, you are all set (just click 'NO' when asked if you want to enter another child) Select 'NEXT' and you will be directed to the challenge page. Here you can switch between readers in the account.

- 1. Under the library logo at the top left corner, you can change between readers to log independent reading for appropriate person.
- 2. To edit your account information or change your password click the 'wheel' at the top right corner and select 'Edit Account'. Here is where you sign out as well.
